- Pray for God to prepare hearts for the harvest (Matthew 9:36-38)

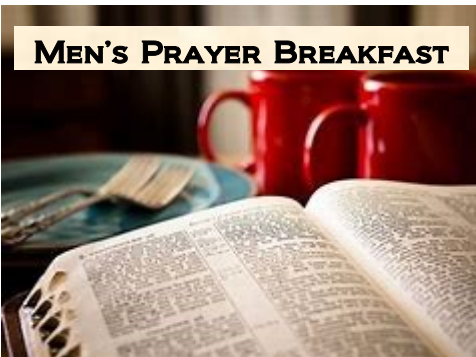
